The next event, which I can aptly name as the "Jewel in the Crown" of all events this year, was the **Century Club Heritage Food Mela**. With twelve of the few remaining restaurants of Bangalore that are 50+ years-old taking part in the Mela, we just could not hazard a guess as to what the crowd would be. Unlike a New Year's Eve, where we have an idea of the number of people who would turn up, the logistics of this mela was really challenging.

The restaurants that took part were Crowns Canopy, Chichaba's Taj Hotel, Ranganna Military Hotel, Asha Sweet Center, Vidyarthi Bhavan, Gundappa Sweets (Sri Ram Vilas Sweets), Brahmin's Coffee Bar, New Krishna Bhavan, Bhagatram Sweets, Sree Vishnu Bhavan, CTR – Central Tiffin Room and Lake View Milk Bar. I was often asked how we managed to get all these people to come to our Club. Trust me, it was a humungous task. *For nearly two months, I personally visited each and every restaurant, not just in the above list, but many more, to convince them to come out of their comfort zone and set up their wares in our mela.* After numerous visits and calls with a lot of following up, my efforts crystalized into the twelve restaurants mentioned above. The response to the Mela was really gratifying and made me feel it was worth all the effort. In fact, in the briefing given to the restaurants by the Hon. Secretary, the restaurants were told to be prepared for around 2000 people and also have a food backup in their respective restaurants in the event of a bigger turnover. To add to the nostalgic ambience, videos instead of audios of old Hindi and Kannada film songs, were played on a large LED screen. The attendance was more than 3,000 people, including nearly 500 guests.

At one point of time, a few years back, the **Table Tennis Section** seemed to be heading towards becoming history with hardly anyone patronizing the game. But now, one should see the transformation. A lovely sit-out designed, executed and sponsored by **The Parquet Company, the promoter of which is our own member Mr. Tarak Shah**, three new top-of-the-line TT tables and a new sports flooring were all done in January. It is my honour to be a part of this wonderful Century Club Executive Committee 2019-20.

When I took over as a Chairman of two very important sports sections, Badminton and Table Tennis, both these sections required a lot of fine tuning with respect to equipment and infrastructural changes. And I must say that the Executive Committee was very co-operative in bringing about these basic upgradations.

The Badminton Section, besides a weekend Coaching Camp for members, saw a lot of activity with two tournaments being conducted. The first was the Beer and Biryani tournament, which was conducted not only for

the regular players of Century Club, but also for members of our Club who were playing Badminton in various other clubs whom we identified and specially invited over for the tournament. Most of them reciprocated and joined in what I may say was a wonderfully organised tournament. In fact, this tournament became the base to bring in more participants for our next tournament, the 3rd Century Club Badminton League (CCBL).

The CCBL saw an excellent participation of 80 players and for the first time the concept of team owners was introduced which was well accepted and appreciated. Now, the CCBL has become one of the best Badminton Leagues amongst all the clubs in Bangalore, and most importantly, it was a self-sustained tournament with sponsorship.

Our most awaited Badminton tournament, the prestigious 17th Garuda Inter Club tournament will see 17 selected clubs in Bangalore taking part. It will be played from 9th February to 15th February 2020, and for the first time we have allowed three state players to participate and represent their respective clubs. It will be one of its kind tournaments, which everyone is looking forward to.

In the Table Tennis Section, we have upgraded the section with a state of the art epoxy and vinyl sports flooring, LED Lights and three new international standard TT tables. In addition, we have created a lounge area for our players to relax after a rigorous game. This section is now ready to conduct and host Inter Club tournaments and will probably be one of the best sports section of Century Club.

This year, even in the Table Tennis league, we introduced the Team Owners concept and with seven teams competing, the excitement level has definitely gone up. The league will be starting from 31st January and will culminate on 8th February 2020. The league is sponsored by Mr. H. V. Vijayaraghavan and Karur Vysya Bank.


