Novel CORONA Virus Infection – (COVID-19)

General:

- Corona virus was identified in 1930, it use to cause mild upper respiratory infection occasionally gastrointes infection
- Novel Corona Virus is a new strain with genetic shift. Identified in China during December 2019 similar to, other viruses -, SARS, MERS.
- Incubation period: 1 to 12.5 days (WHO), median 5-6 days, longest period is 14
- As per experience of Chinese health professionals the infection can starts like cold, sore throat, fever and can lead to pneumonia, complications and death.
- Elderly people and people with pre existing health conditions are more vulnerable for severe illness.
- Virus can spread human to human and animals to human. by droplet infection. Talking produces 100, coughing 1000 sneezing droplets sneezing 100000 droplets.
- There is no evidence contacting the virus from pets Dogs and Cats
- Viruses live longer on shiny surfaces of desks, tables etc up to couple of days.

Do's and Don'ts to protect from infection:

- 1. Social distancing from suspected people:
 - Keep 3 feet away from the people with respiratory symptoms
 - Use Namaste to wish Avoid over crowed places
 - Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth with bare hand.

2. Respiratory Etiquette:

- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water Or Alcohol based hand rub if hands are not visibly dirty
- Cough and sneeze into flexed elbows
- Use tissues and discard immediately and wash hands
- If you use handkerchief use cotton one which will dry early
- Use surgical face mask if you have respiratory symptoms or caring for people with disease and people travelled from endemic area.

- Don't misuse the mask and unnecessary wastage of precious resource
- Seek medical help if you feel sick.

3. Other measures:




